The undersigned affiant, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. That, your affiant, Detective Paul O'Connor has being duly sworn, does depose and state that he is a member of the New Britain Police Department and has been a member since January 21, 1994. At all times mentioned herein he was acting as a member of said department. The following facts and circumstances are stated from personal knowledge and observations as well as information received from other police officers acting in their official capacity and from official police reports and statements made by prudent and credible witnesses.

2. That, your affiant has received specialized training in the investigation of fire and your affiant is certified Fire Investigator with the State of Connecticut Department of Public Safety Office of Education and Data Management-Division of Fire. Your affiant has been granted the authority of Fire Investigator for the City of New Britain.

3. That, on March 11, 2022 at approximately 8:04 p.m., New Britain Public Safety and Telecommunication Center (P.S.T.C.) received an anonymous caller reporting a working fire at the Congregation

Tephereth Israel Synagogue located at 76 Winter Street in New Britain, Connecticut. New Britain P.S.T.C. dispatched several Engine Companies, Ladder Companies and Cars to the scene; a Single Alarm Fire.

4. That, upon arrival, firefighters found a working fire in the basement of the Synagogue; the fire appeared to have breached the first floor and was spreading inside the synagogue. Firefighters forced the front door to the synagogue opened and found a working fire in the church on the east side of the front entrance.

5. That, the basement fire was reported to be knocked down at 8:15 p.m. Firefighters reported fire in the wall cavities of the structure and a hole in the floor where the fire was actively burning. The fire on the first floor was deemed under control at 9:05 p.m.

6. That, at 8:48 p.m., a fire was reported at St Matthew Lutheran Church located at 99 Franklin Square by Simplex Grenelle Johnson Control to the New Britain P.S.T.C., West Hartford Fire Department, Hartford Fire Department and Bristol Fire Department's responded to the scene, to assist in the fire abatement (Two Alarm Fire). West Hartford Firefighters reported a working fire in the kitchen area of the church. The fire was reported to be knocked down at 9:24 p.m.

7. That, on March 11, 2022 at approximately 9:09 p.m., New Britain Police Officer Bartosz Wichowski reported an audible alarm activated at St. Joseph's Church located at 195 South Main Street. Officer Wichowski found no active fire or damage to the building. The building was searched and cleared with no one found inside the

church. A black latex glove was found on the ground on the south side of the church.

8. That, the Congregation Tephareth Israel Synagogue located at 76 Winter Street had damage to the east side basement entrance which is believed to be the point of entry for the burglary. This is also the area of origin for the fire which was initially reported as having heavy smoke coming from the basement area on the east side. The fire appears to have been a smoldering type fire initially in the basement which accounts for the heavy smoke which work its way up through the wall cavities and burning through the floor joists and floor boards creating a large hole in the floor near the front entrance (south side facing Winter Street).

9. That, New Britain Fire Marshal Donald King arrived on scene at 76 Winter Street and upon conducting his cause and origin investigation it was determined that there were a total of three (3) points of origin which were separate and non-communicating in the basement. The three points of origin were found to be in the basement on the south side of the building. One of the points of origin was on a desk, another on a chair, and the third on the floor of the basement. The fire appeared to be Incendiary so the State Fire Marshal and the New Britain Police Department Criminal Investigation Division were requested to assist in the arson investigation.

10. That, St. Matthew Lutheran Church located at 99 Franklin Square had damage to the kitchen area which is adjacent to the gymnasium. There was a large concrete type pot which was thrown at the glass pane on the door which smashed the glass allowing entry into the

building by manipulating the door handle from inside the building. Combustible items were placed on top of a stove which was turned on igniting a fire in the kitchen.





11. That, the distance from 76 Winter Street to 99 Franklin Square is 1.2 miles. The distance from 99 Franklin Square to 195 South Main Street is 0.4 miles.

12. That, New Britain Police Officers were on alert status prior to the fires on March 11, 2022, due to several fires, vandalisms to churches and a vacant home within the last few days. A rock had been thrown through a window at the Greek Orthodox Church, a burglary and a small fire was set at a church on Curtis St and there was a house fire in a vacant home on Grove Hill.

13. That, on March 11, 2022, a person of interest was developed in the vandalism and fires that were occurring over the past few days. A person identified as Kimorah Parker (DOB of 09/13/1991) was observed walking on West Main Street in the area of the Greek Orthodox Church immediately after the church was vandalized. Kimorah Parker had also posted on Facebook, a comment about the fire at the vacant home within hours of the house fire.

14. That, on March 11, 2022 at approximately 5:30 p.m., New Britain Criminal Investigation Division Captain Matthew Marino observed Kimorah Parker in the area of South Church located at the corner of Arch Street and Chestnut Street in New Britain. Captain Marino reported that Kimorah Parker was wearing black and white camouflage slacks, dark colored jacket, with hair tied up with in a bun. At

approximately 6:00 p.m. New Britain Police Officer Jeffry Nedderman observed Kimorah Parker on Winter Street in the rear of New Brite Plaza.

15. That, Detective Karl Mordasiewicz was monitoring New Britain Police Department City Cameras and the New Brite Plaza Camera System and he observed Kimorah Parker wearing the same clothing described by Captain Marino walking west bound on Winter Street at approximately 6:15 p.m., Kimorah Parker is then seen turning into the alley way of the synagogue walking north bound which leads to the east side basement entry door, which is where the force entry into the basement occurred and the location where the fire was believed to have started (south east side basement).

16. That, on March 11, 2022 at approximately 9:54 p.m., Sgt. John Prisavage observed Kimorah Parker in the area of the Christian Pentecostal Church located at 119 West Main Street. Sgt Prisavage stopped Parker on suspicion of being involved in a least one fire (76 Winter Street) and possible involvement in the fire at 99 Franklin Square and the alarm activation at 195 South Main Street in New Britain. Sgt Prisavage detained Kimorah Parker until additional units arrived on scene. Parker struggled with the officers attempting to flee the scene and she was subsequently arrested on scene for Interfering with an Officer.

17. That, Officer Sloate and his K-9 partner, Marley were sent to 99 Franklin Square to conduct a K-9 track utilizing the scent from the latex glove that was discarded on the south side of St. Matthew Lutheran Church. The track led to West Main and High Street where

Kimorah Parker was being detained by New Britain Police Officers.

18. That, upon a search incident to a full custody arrest, New Britain Police Officers Nicole Eldredge and Todd Krolikowski found several items on Kimorah Parker's person which included a smart phone, two (2) butane lighters with labels partially burnt, distinct skeleton type keys, a stack of Fleet Bank deposit slips inside a plastic bag, several pieces of mail, receipts, bills, and checks, which had one common denominator, they were addressed to the synagogue located at 76 Winter Street. Some of the items found on Parker's person were as follows; a check made out to a third party from the Congregation Tephareth Israel in 1999, a Fleet Bank Transaction Receipt in 2000 with the Congregation Tephareth Israel Inc. listed, several bills from Barrieau Oil Company Inc to the Congregation Tephareth Israel dated 2006, these items would be normally found in an office or similar room used to store receipts and bills associated with the day to day bills accumulated when running a business or ministry.

19. That, Kimorah Parker was arrested and transported to the New Britain Police Department where she was placed in an interview room. Parker refused to be given her Miranda Rights saying instead she would Mirandize your affiant. Clothing worn by Parker had an odor of smoke; the outer layer of clothing was seized and placed in brown paper bags. Kimorah was given a hospital gown and she demanded to be taken to the hospital for suicidal ideations. She was given a police escort when she was transported to the Hospital of Central Connecticut New Britain General for mental health evaluation.

20. That, according to the Connecticut State Police Records Check (SPRC), Kimorah Tyree Parker also known as Akeem McDavid (DOB of 09/13/1991), has been arrested and or convicted for criminal charges

21. That, your affiant believes on March 11, 2022, Kimorah Parker (DOB of 09/13/1991), illegally entered a vacant synagogue located at 76 Winter Street in New Britain, Connecticut by forcibly opening the door to access the building. Parker then stole outdated and antiquated mail, bills and receipts which had correspondence from and to the Congregation Tephareth Israel Synagogue. Parker then proceeded to set multiple fires in the basement with the apparent attempt to cause a larger fire which engulf the building and burn or severely damage the synagogue.

22. That according to the Security Director for Jewish Synagogues, the Congregation Tephareth Israel Synagogue had been vacant for at least two years and the electrical power had been disconnected.

23. That, Kimorah Parker (DOB of 09/13/1991) was captured by surveillance camera walking in an alley that leads to the east side basement entrance to the synagogue where forced entry was made into the building. Parker was found to have in her possession an ignition source (two butane lighters), there was an odor of smoke that emanated from her outer clothing, and she had documents that could only have been obtained by gaining access inside the building. All potential sources for the fire have been ruled out such as,
