On 11/01/22 at approximately 2100 hours I, Sergeant Laone was responding to a fatal motor vehicle accident (refer CN# 22-106997) where I heard Officers on scene call out a hit and run vehicle (Dark Jaguar sedan with heavy rear end damage) that struck a police cruiser inside the crime scene from the above mentioned fatal accident. (see attached Accident Report) Officer R. Torres observed the vehicle, and attempted to stop it (see attached supplement), the operator, later identified as Myrice Hodge (08-25-87) fled in the Jaguar. During the pursuit Officer Torres called out a location (Highland Ave by 84 off ramp) where Hodge threw an item out the window. The pursuit continued until Hodge attempted to run on foot inside 222 Bradley Ave., where he was taken into custody by Officer Torres (see attached supplement).

I then returned to the original crash scene and was able to observe video of the incident provided by CBS News Reporter, Christian Colon who was on scene from the original crash. That video shows Hodge in his 2010 Jaguar XF (VIN SAJWA0FA9AHR63491) bearing NJ TEMP J005401, driving in the clearly marked off crash scene with police vehicles and caution tape blocking the entire road. There are numerous officers (Bliss, Girouard, Gonzalez, Moran, Bonicki, Bartoli and Sergeant Benoit) on foot attempting to get Hodge to stop the vehicle. Hodge continued to ignore all officers verbal commands and continued to drive forward

through the crime scene with officers surrounding the vehicle. Hodge then put his vehicle in reverse, at a high rate of speed putting all 7 Officers lives in danger, and struck police cruiser 15 which was unoccupied blocking the roadway. The Jaguar suffered extensive rear end damage and Car 15 suffered disabling damage.

I then viewed several Officers Body Worn Camera (BWC) that were on scene which also showed Hodge enter the clearly marked crime scene, past two cruisers blocking the street along with crime scene tape across Chase Ave. Hodge travels west on Chase Ave., with numerous Officers giving verbal commands, which he ignores. Hodge then briefly stops in the west end of the crime scene as numerous Officers have the Jaguar surrounded giving verbal commands and Hodge ignores them and goes in reverse, east through the crime scene striking marked cruiser 15, and flees over the curb into the Aldi's (62 Chase Ave) parking lot, striking an unoccupied parked car (CT AR 05766) and speeds off North on North Main St.

In viewing Officer Moran's BWC after the crash into the police vehicle, Officers chased the vehicle on foot still giving verbal commands. As Hodge flees the scene after striking the police cruiser he misses running over Officer Moran by inches and flees over the curb into the Aldi's Parking Lot.

In viewing Officer Bliss BWC he approaches Hodge vehicle from the south sidewalk and attempts to open the drivers door yelling "stop, stop." As Officer Bliss attempts to get the drivers door open Hodge accelerated in reverse, putting Officer Bliss in danger of being struck or dragged by the vehicle. Hodge then crashed into vehicle 15, and flees the scene, also striking CT AR05766 in the Aldi's parking lot. The other 4 Officers and Sergeant Benoit gave similar versions of the incident, All were offered and refused medical attention.

Officers canvassed the area where Hodge threw the item out the window and located 21 bundles of Heroin. Forensics

responded to the Chase Ave., scene and the Highland Ave, scene, took photographs and collected the evidence. Lieutenant Switz was notified of the incident and responded to the scene.

An NCIC check shows the NJ TEMP registration on Hodge Jaguar to have no information found. The VIN was also checked and came back to a canceled registration with no insurance information. An inventory of the vehicle showed a "Foremost Insurance Company" Insurance card. Officer Delasio called a Tenetra Crawford with the company who stated that no such policy is active for the Jaguar at this time.

Due to Hodge's extreme indifference to human life, using his vehicle as a deadly weapon, he was arrested and charged with 2 counts of Criminal Attempt at Assault 1st (Officer Moran and Bliss), 7 counts of Reckless Endangerment 1st, 2 counts of Evading Responsibility, Engaging Police in Pursuit, Operating an Unregistered MV, Insufficient Insurance, Operating without a license, Interfering with an Officer, and Possession of Narcotics with intent to sell.

On 11/1/2022 at approximately 2040 hours, this Unit A1B, was assisting several other patrol units with securing and processing a crime scene / fatal pedestrian accident (refer to case # 22-106997) located in the roadway in front of 62 Chase Avenue (Aldi's).

While on scene, Sgt. Benoit (S1B), Ofc. Moran (A2B), Ofc. Bonicki (A5B), members of the Crash Reconstruction Unit (CRU), and I observed a dark colored sedan traveling West on Chase Avenue at a high rate of speed. The vehicle traveled past multiple marked Police cruisers that had the emergency lights activated and crime scene tape marking off areas to indicate that the roadway was not accessible at this time. The vehicle then continued to travel towards several Officers including myself and the driver, later identified as Myrice Hodge (DOB 08/25/1987), did not appear that he was going to stop. Officers immediately began to scream verbal commands to Myrice in an attempt to get his attention and make him stop the vehicle. The vehicle then came to a complete stop at the intersection of Chase Avenue and Hill Street. Officers approached the vehicle and shouted verbal commands to Myrice to get out of the vehicle. Myrice ignored all Officers commands and began to travel in reverse in an aggressive manner almost striking several Officers. When the vehicle began to travel in reverse myself and other Officers began to run East on Chase Avenue towards the vehicle while continuing to scream verbal commands to Myrice to stop the vehicle. The rear of the vehicle then struck a marked Police cruiser (refer to original report and accident report). Believing that the Myrice was going to cause serious physical injury by driving the vehicle towards myself and the other Officers on scene, I unholstered my department issued firearm (serial # HSZ55561) and pointed it directly at the driver side front window of the vehicle while continuously giving verbal commands to Myrice to get out of the vehicle. Myrice then drove straight for a brief

moment before driving over the curb and into the parking lot of Aldi's almost striking bystanders. I began to chase after the vehicle for a short distance but Myrice fled the area. I then holstered my firearm and returned to the crime scene.

Sgt. Benoit (S1B) was present when this incident occurred and notified of my actions. A Use of Force was completed and submitted.

On 11/1/2022 at 2040 hrs. I, Ofc. Bonicki (A5B), was assisting multiple other patrol units with securing the scene of a fatal motor vehicle accident involving a pedestrian (CN22-106997) in the roadway in front of 62 Chase Ave(Aldi's).

While on scene, Sgt. Benoit (S1B), Ofc. Moran (A2B), Ofc. Bartoli (A1B), members of the Crash Reconstruction Unit (CRU) and I observed a dark colored vehicle traveling West on Chase Ave at a high rate of speed attempting to go around multiple marked Police cruiser's that had their emergency lights activated parked across Chase Ave. The vehicle drove around multiple Police cruisers and crime scene tape that was secured by officers at a high rate of speed heading directly towards officers outside of their vehicles on scene. Officers began screaming verbal commands at the operator later identified as Myrice Hodge(8/25/1987) of the vehicle to stop his vehicle. Hodge stopped his vehicle at the intersection of Chase Ave and Hill street. Officers surrounded the vehicle screaming at Hodge to stop and get out of the vehicle. Hodge ignored all of officers verbal commands and put the vehicle in reverse almost striking multiple officers surrounding the vehicle. Hodge began traveling East bound in reverse on Chase Ave at a high rate of speed where he struck a marked Police cruiser that was parked across the road. Officers began to chase after the vehicle on foot where we then surrounded the vehicle. In fear of Hodge causing serious physical injury to myself and other officers I un holstered my department issued firearm and pointed my it directly at Hodge while continuing to give verbal commands. Hodge began to drive forward after striking the Police cruiser almost hitting multiple officers on foot before driving over the curb and into the parking lot of Aldi's. Hodge almost struck multiple pedestrians while traveling at a high rate of speed through the parking lot of Aldi's. I holstered my firearm once the vehicle had left the area.

On 11/1/22 at 2046 hours, Officers on scene of a fatal motor vehicle accident at 62 Chase Ave broadcasted that a dark Jaguar sedan struck a police cruiser, nearly struck multiple officers, and fled north on North Main St.

I, Officer Torres, responded to the area to search for the striking vehicle, which was described as a black sedan with heavy rear end damage and a temporary plate. As I was traveling north on North Main St, at approximately 2051 hours, a vehicle matching the description broadcasted by officers passed by me, traveling south on North Main St. I then turned around and attempted to stop the vehicle by using my emergency lights and sirens, at which point the vehicle failed to yield, continued south on North Main St and turned right onto Perkins Ave. Due to the nature of the incident and the fact that the suspect posed a danger to the public, I continued to pursue the suspect vehicle. The suspect vehicle then continued at a high rate of speed down Perkins Ave through light traffic before turning left onto Cooke St. The suspect vehicle then turned right onto Homer St and continued to operate at a high rate of speed through intersections. I continuously attempted to stop the suspect vehicle, which failed to yield before turning left onto Thomaston Ave, increasing speed and driving recklessly through traffic. The suspect vehicle continued down Thomaston Ave and turned right onto West Main St, continuing at a high rate of speed through multiple intersections. The suspect vehicle then turned left onto Highland Ave and continued at a high rate of speed. As the suspect vehicle was approaching the intersection of Highland Ave at Oak Hill Ave, I observed what appeared to be numerous white objects thrown out of the vehicle by the driver to the side of the road, which was broadcasted over police radio. Officer Zulali responded to the area and secured the evidence which consisted of 21 bundles of a brown powdered substance in white glassine bags, consistent with heroin. Forensics collected the 21 bundles of heroin from the scene.

The suspect vehicle then continued down Highland Ave before turning right onto Bradley Ave. The suspect Vehicle continued down Bradley Ave before entering the parking lot of 222 Bradley Ave. The suspect vehicle then slowed to a crawl in front of building 2, which is when a black male wearing a dark hoodie and jeans later identified as Hodge, exited the driver's side of the vehicle and fled into building 2 of 222 Bradley Ave. Myself and Officer Machado engaged the suspect in a brief foot pursuit down a hallway of building 2, never losing sight of him, and giving him multiple verbal commands to stop running. When I caught up with the suspect, I grabbed him by the upper body and gave him verbal commands to get on the ground. The suspect then attempted to pull away, which is when Officer Machado and I each grabbed one of his arms and escorted him to the ground. The suspect, later identified as Myrice Hodge (DOB 08/25/1987) was then placed in handcuffs and taken into custody. While in custody, Myrice stated "I didn't mean to hit the cop car" and "I was just trying to get home." Upon further investigation, and after reviewing police dash cameras, it was found that Hodge was a solo occupant in the vehicle. Myrice was transported to police headquarters to be booked and processed.

On 11/1/2022, at approximately 2046 hours, officers on scene of an active fatal pedestrian accident on Chase Ave. (REF 22-106997) called out over the radio that a dark colored Jaguar with paper plates collided into one of their police cruisers and nearly hit officers on scene. Units were in the area canvassing, when Officer Reynaldo Torres called over the radio that he is behind the vehicle on N Main St. Moments later the vehicle refused to stop and fled. Officer Torres continued the pursuit south on Thomaston Ave towards W Main St.

I was traveling west on W Main St when I observed the suspected vehicle make a right turn onto W Main St from Thomaston Ave with a police cruiser following. I activated my emergency lights and sirens and engaged in the pursuit west on W Main St and turned left onto Highland Ave. I observed the vehicle traveling recklessly at a high rate of speed. Due to the severity of the incident, light vehicle and pedestrian traffic, I continued to assist in the pursuit. The vehicle continued to fail to yield to the emergency lights and sirens and continued south on Highland Ave. The vehicle then turned right onto Bradley Ave and continued west down it. The suspects vehicle then turned into the parking lot of 222 Bradley Ave and stopped in front of building 2. I observed a black male, later identified as Myrice Hodge (8/25/1987), begin to exit the driver seat as I continued forward to the front entrance of building 2. I then observed Officer Torres and Officer Machado begin to give chase after the black male into building 2. I observed Myrice refuse their commands to stop and run inside the building.

I also observed a female, later identified as Samara Roberson (7/8/1998), leave the passenger side area of the vehicle and

began to follow them inside. After several commands for Samara to stop and not knowing if Samara was in the vehicle or involved, Samara ignored my commands and continued inside the lobby. While attempting to place Samara in handcuffs, she attempts to resist by pulling her arms away from me. I then pushed Samara against the wall, grabbed her by the arms, and brought her hands behind her back to place her in handcuffs. Samara was placed into the rear of my police cruiser pending investigation. Samara continued to state she was not in the vehicle and the suspect was her boyfriend.

Upon further review of dash cams, it was determined Samara was not in the vehicle and waiting on the side. Once this information came to light, Samara was released from my cruiser and the handcuffs were taken off. Samara was upset over the incident and walked away with her mother. Once released, I assisted Officer Torres with transporting Myrice to police headquarters for booking and processing.

On 11/01/2022 I, Ofc Ahearn, was dispatched to the area of Chase Ave and N Main St to assist units in locating an evading vehicle. While enroute I was advised via the police radio that a dark colored jaguar sedan had just struck a police cruiser, almost struck multiple police officers while driving through an active crime scene, and almost struck numerous pedestrians in the parking lot of Aldi's Grocery Store (62 Chase Ave). The suspect vehicle in question was said to have heavy rear end damage, a NJ temporary registration displayed on the rear of the vehicle, and a shattered back windshield.

Upon arrival in the area, while traveling north on N Main St, I observed a vehicle (2010 Jaguar Xf, NJ Temp: J005401, VIN# SAJWA0FA9AHR63491) traveling south on N Main St towards Perkins Ave that identically matched the description provided by officers on scene. I activated my emergency lights and sirens and turned around in the street to attempt to stop the vehicle. In doing so Ofc. Rey. Torres, who was traveling south on N Main St, was able to drive around my cruiser and attempt to stop the vehicle. The vehicle refused to stop for Ofc Torres and myself at which point, due to the severity of the crime the operator was involved in, it was determined the operator posed a significant risk to public safety should he not be apprehended. At the time of this incident vehicular traffic was light with no pedestrian traffic, therefore, we continued to pursue the vehicle. The vehicle and it's operator, later identified as Myrice Quane Hodge (DOB 08/25/1987), fled south on N Main St taking a right onto Perkins Ave. Myrice proceeded to ignore police signals to stop and continued to flee in an attempt to avoid apprehension. Myrice ultimately turned left on Cooke St, right on Chase Ave, left on Thomaston Ave, right on W Main St, left on Highland Ave, right on Bradley Ave, and finally pulled into the apartment complex parking lot of 222 Bradley Ave where he struck the building (Building# 2) (Reference CN# 22-107034).

Due to being behind multiple cruisers in the parking lot I was unable to see the occupants exit the vehicle. It was announced on the police radio at the end of the pursuit that it's occupants were beginning to flee on foot. I parked my marked police cruiser and ran towards the entrance way to the building at which point I observed Ofc Hernandez attempting to detain a female party, later identified as Samara Larea Roberson (DOB 07/08/1998). Samara was actively physically resisting Ofc Hernandez who was attempting to place Samara in handcuffs. Due to the severity of the incident and the fact Samara was actively resisting Ofc Hernandez, I placed my right forearm into Samara's back and pushed her against the wall to immobilize her while giving her verbal commands to "give us your hands." I then assisted Ofc Hernandez in controlling Samara's hands behind her back at which point Ofc Hernandez was able to secure Samara in handcuffs without further incident. Samara was then placed in the rear of a marked police cruiser pending further investigation.

Once Samara and Myrice were effectively detained I returned to the suspect vehicle from the pursuit. Inside the vehicle I observe there to be a small pack of white glassine folds wrapped in a rubber band in plain view on the driver's seat of the vehicle. From my training and experience I know these glassine folds to be consistent with heroin and the way it is packaged for street sale and consumption. The vehicle was secured at this time by patrol units and held as a crime scene pending further investigation. Ofc Dalessio stood by the vehicle, later towing it to Police H.Q. An inventory search of the vehicle located a second bundle of 10 white glassine folds in the center console of the vehicle.
